BIOGRAPHY

Director Edouard A. Tremblay began his career with the Phylactère Cola group, whose comedy shows were broadcast on Télé-Québec. He then made a name for himself with his short film *La bataille de Farador*, which was screened at festivals around the world, and more widely on the web, where it generated millions of views. Since then, he has directed over 51 episodes of the animated series *Cracké*, produced by Squeeze Studio and sold internationally in over 150 territories. In 2016, he co-directed a feature-length anticipation film entitled *Feuille Mortes* starring Roy Dupuis. The film traveled to several festivals. It won the Jury Prize for Best Canadian Film and the Silver Audience Award at the 2016 Fantasia Festival, as well as the First Jury Prize at the 2016 Rhode Island International Film Festival. In the spring of 2023, *Farador*, his first solo feature, adapted from the successful short film, opened in nearly 70 theaters across Quebec. Warmly received by critics and audiences alike, the film spent 5 weeks in the top 10 of the Quebec Box-Office. The film is also starting its festival career, and has already won two Audience Awards (Dieppe Canadian Film Festival, France and Festival Cinéma du monde de Sherbrooke) and a Special Mention from the "Emerging Raven" jury at the Brussels International Fantastic Film Festival in Belgium. *Farador* will be distributed in Europe in the coming year.
